The meetings will take place on Sunday, March 14th at 10am and 1pm, at the Palace of Fine Arts Theater in San Francisco (see flyer for map). Both will feature a guest lecture by Greg Martin on attaining happiness through Buddhism. The only difference between the two meetings will be the experiences presented.
